MINUTES

1. Pledge of Allegiance

Chair Conley convened the meeting at 7:00 PM.

Councilor White led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call

3. Public Forum

Chair Conley opened the public forum at 7:03 PM.

Cris Blackstone, Spring Street, is the Chair of the Conservation Commission and recognized Tom Jones, a member of the Conservation Commission whose resignation is on the agenda to be acted on by the Council. She thanked him for serving on the Commission. She said Lucas Fromm is applying as an alternate member to the commission and Zachary Angelini is applying for the full member position vacated by Tom Jones.

Chair Conley closed the public forum at 7:05 PM.

4. Public Hearing

- a.** Resolution #2025/2026-02 - Authorize the Conservation Commission to enter into a Purchase & Sales Agreement with the Rosa Family Trust for a Conservation Easement

Chair Conley opened the public hearing at 7:05pm.

Ellen Snyder, member of the Conservation Commission explained that the Commission has been working with the Rosa Family since last July to acquire a 16.3 acre conservation easement. The Commission received a \$100,000 grant from the Lamprey River Advisory Committee, and they applied for a grant from LCHIP, and plan to apply for other grants. The Commission will conduct a site walk on August 14th at 4:30 PM prior to their regular meeting at 7:00 PM.

Conley closed the public hearing at 7:07 PM.

7. Report of the Town Manager

- a. Report of the Town Manager July 16, 2025

Updating Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP) and the Emergency Operations Plan (EOP): Hubbard Consulting LLC will be updating the EOP and the COOP. These updates are both timely and cost-effective. By updating both plans, we will ensure that Newmarket will remain compliant with state and federal standards and is well positioned to protect public safety and maintain vital services in times of crisis. The combined project cost is \$6,600.00 , with 50% coming from a Homeland Security Grant. It will be completed over the next several months.

Hazard Mitigation Plan: In addition, the Town has completed a full update of its Hazard Mitigation Plan, which was last revised in 2018. It was led by the Hazard Mitigation Committee with support from Strafford Regional Planning and NH Homeland Security, and identifies risks from natural, technological, and human-caused hazards and lays out strategies to protect life, property, and critical infrastructure. Keeping the plan current also ensures we stay eligible for FEMA funding. A formal resolution to adopt the plan will be needed in the near future. After meeting with the Commissioner of NH DOT they were able to agree to \$375,000 in funding. It is now awaiting Governor and Council approval.

Packers Falls Drainage Upgrades: We are working with NH DOT about managing a drainage replacement project on Packer's Falls Road. The scope has grown to 14 structures, with an estimated cost of \$396,930. NH DOT offered \$350,000 in funding. Public Works is concerned about possible ledge.

Update to Disable Veteran's Tax Credit: House Bill 99 passed and allows municipalities to increase the Service-Connected Disabled Veteran Tax Credit under RSA 72:35 I-a from the previous cap of \$4,000 to up to \$5,000. This credit replaces any veteran-related tax credits the individual might receive - it is not an addition to them. To ensure veterans receive both the \$4,000 credit and the regular \$750 veteran credit, we propose to increase the service-connected amount to \$4,750.00.

8. **Committee Reports**

Councilor Dornblut reported on the Public Transportation Committee:

They conducted a site walk at New Village and discussed the one-way traffic pattern. It is not clearly identified and causes hazardous conditions from drivers driving the wrong way. They will have a meeting in the fall to discuss those issues with the public. The Committee is working on a transportation policy that they hope to submit to the Councilors by the end of the year.

Councilor Glazebrook commented that the Arts, Culture & Tourism Commission will hold an ice-cream social on National Night Out, August 5th at Schanda Park, and the band Truffle will be playing. The garden tour was a success. Local artists sold their art. Councilors are welcome to volunteer at the ice cream social to serve ice cream.

They will be doing fund-raising and scheduling site walks on the property over the summer and fall. The Newmarket side will be a private easement and the Durham side will be a public easement.
